Scripture: Colossians 4: 1-3

Q1. Laurence stated that “change” during the Covid crisis has tended to create spiritual openness. Have you found that to be true? Please share your experience.

Q2. Can you identify and list the people you have had more contact with during this period? Let's start by praying for them. If we can't identify anyone, then let's ask God to inspire us to take notice of those in our everyday circle.

Q3. With Sunday services closed or restricted, Laurence stated individuals became the missional front line. Do you think this is true and do you see yourself as the missional front line?

Q4. Laurence stated that times of crisis or personal change causes us to re evaluate our world view and is often a path leading to people becoming followers of Jesus. What do you think of this?

Optional deeper personal study: Look up Colossians 4:3 in several translations and reflect on – What does proclaiming the mystery of Christ successfully mean, when most people have little knowledge of the bible
